## \$5.00 FINDER'S FEE

Each year the ISA publishes Arboricultural Abstracts. These are information sheets on particular subject matter areas. Each sheet contains abstracts of 17-20 papers that appeared in a scientific or technical journal. The articles must be of interest or benefit to individuals concerned with the latest information on arboricultural subjects. The articles are abstracted especially for these sheets by the ISA Editor. He, however, needs help in securing the reprints or photocopies to abstract. This is a plea to everyone who reads scientific or technical material. Be the first to send in an article selected for abstracting and receive a \$5.00 finder's fee for each one. The most likely to be accepted are those published in 1990 and with an application for informed arborists. Ten articles equals \$50.00. Closing date for 1991 is March 15.
